

LOW COST BINS KERBSIDE RECYCLING

ACCEPTED ✓

Plastics 1, 2, & 5



Water, juice and soft drink bottles.



Milk, shampoo & cleaning product bottles.



Large yoghurt container & ice cream tubs.

Notes

- No lids
- Do not squish
- If you can't locate one of these numbers please place it in your general waste bin.



Glass

- Rinsed bottles and jars.
- Lids must go in your rubbish bin.
- No broken glass.



Cans

- Clean and do not squash.
- Include the tops inside the can, and pinch the can closed.



Paper & Cardboard

- Flattened and clean.
- Cardboard packaging, newspapers, brochures, office paper, magazines, books, clean pizza boxes, egg cartons, window envelopes.
- Flattened cardboard should be no larger than your crate or bin.



NOT ACCEPTED ✗

Plastics 3, 4, 6 & 7



Some cracker trays.



Some squeeze bottles.



Small dairy pottles and tubs.



Fresh pasta and deli packages



Soft Plastics

- E.g. shrink wrap, bubble wrap, chip packets, chocolate bar wrappers.

Note

- If you can scrunch the plastic into a ball, it's a soft plastic.

Lined Drink Cartons

- E.g. Lined drink cartons, coffee cups, contaminated paper, tissues & paper towels



Polystyrene

- Packaging, takeaway food and beverage containers and black meat trays.

Note

- No polystyrene, even if it has a number on it.

Dangerous Goods

- Aerosol cans & broken glass can damage recycling equipment, injury our employees & contaminate a load a recycling.
